Did you know?

The word 'Medici' stems back to the Italian Medici family of bankers, merchants and rulers of Florence and Tuscany, prominent in political and cultural history in the 15th, 16th and 17th centuries. Most famous for their patronage of the arts, the Medici family would pay artists commissions for major works of art and had a massive impact on the Renaissance, allowing artists to focus on their work without having to worry about money.

Chris Ungar together with Rohan and Toni Milne of Rohan Jewellers have designed a Medici pin to celebrate and symbolise the community of arts lovers the Medici are.

Taking inspiration from the 'Stemma Medici' silk velvet that inspired the Medici name, a contemporary yet classic pin has been designed. Adding a distinct West Australian touch, each pin is set with an Argyle Champagne Diamond sourced from the renowned Argyle Diamond Mine in the East Kimberley.

The pins are available in either sterling silver or 9-carat gold, with Rohan Jewellers offering these at the special cost price of \$150 or \$390 respectively.

We take an annual order for Medici pins at the Medici launch event, so that you can have them in time for the upcoming Festival.
